TELL YOUR CITY COUNCIL MEMBER ... you support \$11 million for the new Animal Shelter!

The City of Dallas is getting ready to build a brand-new animal shelter. But the amount approved in the last bond election isn't nearly enough!

The architects have developed two proposals that require additional funding. But only ONE of these plans will permit Animal Control to do the following:

- Hold impounded cats and dogs FIVE days instead of THREE – giving you two more days to rescue your beloved pet.
- Provide FIVE TIMES as many cages as the old shelter – so that MORE animals can be housed, MORE animals saved, and MORE animals adopted.
- Allow more space for veterinary care and isolation areas – so that MORE animals can be SAVED – and FEWER animals euthanized.
- Create a classroom for humane education, so that kids can be taught about responsible pet ownership BEFORE it's too late.
